

Memorandum of Understanding

Agreement between the All-Party Parliamentary Group on Anti-Corruption ('the APPG' or 'the Group') and Global Witness to provide £5,000 to contribute towards its activities in 2016.

1. Overview

This Memorandum of Understanding between the All Party Parliamentary Group on Anti-Corruption and Global Witness sets out the terms by which Global Witness provides funding to the APPG including the objective, use and outcome of funds. ←

2. Objective



The objective of providing funds to the APPG is to enable the latter to increase parliamentary activity around anti-corruption activities however that is defined by the Group's membership. Funds provided can be used by the Group in whatever way the Members see fit towards this end, within the parliamentary regulations regarding all-party parliamentary groups as defined by the Parliamentary Commissioner for Standards.

3. Funding Purpose

Global Witness funds the APPG because it believes in the importance of increased parliamentary activity around anti-corruption activities and believes the APPG is in a position to deliver it. Global Witness does not fund the Group in order to gain any influence over its activities or to increase its access to parliamentarians. Funding in no way entitles Global Witness to any rights unavailable to non-funders, including but not limited to the setting of objectives for the APPG and decisions over any specific activity.

4. Reporting

The Coordinator will provide three-monthly reports to funders throughout the grant period.
